4.5. Kayla's Angels Monty is the EMS director in West Des Moines. Georgie and her husband have met with him to get AEDs in the West Des Moines soccer fields. Oct would be their kick-off at every soccer event to provide people at soccer games. Monty offered CPR training. They have partnered with Iowa Health.
